FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

No. 01

Do you have to be a member?

We are a private Club. Membership is required to play at The Club at Castle Bluff. Members 15 years old or younger must be accompanied by a parent to play.

No. 02

Can a member bring a guest? What do first-time guests need to do before playing?

Yes, members can bring guests! The day pass is \$10 plus the court fee. First-time guests must sign a waiver, which is updated yearly. Guests must check in at the clubhouse upon arrival to confirm the signed waiver. The waiver can be found on our website www.castlebluffgolf.com/crowncourtpickleball.

Do I need my own equipment?

Yes, you will need to bring your own pickleball equipment. At this time, The Club at Castle Bluff does not offer rental paddles or balls.

Do you have a dress code?

Our Pickleball Dress Code: To ensure a comfortable and enjoyable experience for all players, please adhere to the following dress code:

- Footwear: Non-marking athletic shoes are required to prevent damage to the court surface.
- Apparel: Wear comfortable athletic clothing suitable for physical activity. This includes moisture-wicking shirts, shorts, or skirts. No Jeans, Flip Flops, or Crop Tops: They are not appropriate for pickleball play and the Club.
- Hats and Sunglasses: Optional but recommended for sunny conditions. Hats must be worn the appropriate way.
- Accessories: Please avoid wearing jewelry that could potentially cause injury or distraction during play.

Can I bring my own food and beverage into the Club?

No outside food or beverage is prohibited. The Club features a water bottle refilling station and snack bar where you can purchase snacks, soft drinks, as well as a selection of beer, wine, and mixed drinks.

How do I reserve a court?

To reserve a pickleball court, you must first become a Crown Court Member. Once you join, you will receive a Member Guidebook that walks you through the step-by-step process of accessing our member portal, booking a court through CourtReserve, and managing or canceling reservations.

How many courts do you have?

We have four outdoor pickleball courts, uniquely designed in our club colors with privacy netting to create a distinct playing experience.

Since your courts are outdoors, how many months are you open?

Our outdoor pickleball courts are open from March through October, weather permitting, giving you eight months to enjoy the game in a beautiful setting.

Is there a contract with the membership?

No, our memberships are flexible and do not require a long-term contract. You can sign up for our 3-month minimum membership.
